#### **UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR I-II-III**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a detail oriented, professional individual to fill an Auditor I/II/III position in our Financial Analysis Unit, Jefferson City office.

This is a technical position that is deeply involved in analyzing utility capital markets, financial statements and financial models. The position requires the ability to accurately prepare and present financial recommendations/testimony, in both oral and written form in quasi-judicial proceedings before the Commission. The employee in this position must be able to communicate analysis in an effective manner with little supervision and a degree of independent judgment. The employee will be expected to independently research academic studies as they relate to cost of capital estimation. Auditors must possess a high level of competence, responsibility, professionalism, initiative and integrity. Candidates should be familiar with general financial theories and financial practices that include general knowledge of financial models, including investment valuation and cost of capital methods such as the discounted cash flow method, the Capital Asset Pricing Model, risk premium method, etc. Also, should have the ability to understand financial ratios used to assess corporate creditworthiness. Some travel required.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of accounting or finance coursework required. Good communication, interpersonal skills, and writing skills are essential. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint, with special emphasis on spreadsheet/Excel knowledge and skills.

The annual salary for Utility Regulatory Auditor I is \$37,548; Utility Regulatory Auditor II is \$39,624; and Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$46,932 with potential increases at the end of a successful probationary period.
