UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR I-II-III

State regulatory agency seeks to fill a Utility Regulatory Auditor I-II-III position to perform analysis related to energy issues that affect Missouri's investor owned electric utilities and their customers.

This is a responsible professional auditing position related to utility regulation, accounting, regulatory auditing and electric utility resource planning. The employee in this position must be able to handle complex and multiple audit areas. The employee will be responsible for reviewing electric utility resource plan filings, designing fuel adjustment clause tariffs, monitoring fuel adjustment clause filings and prudence reviews, and monitoring utility compliance with renewable energy standards.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of accounting coursework required. Experience in a regulatory environment that provides a broad view of regulation, utility operations, cost evaluation and management analysis is preferred. Familiarity with renewable energy resources, technologies and standards a plus. Good communication and interpersonal skills required. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Office preferred. Travel required.

The annual salary for Utility Regulatory Auditor I is \$36,672; Utility Regulatory Auditor II is \$38,724; and Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$45,960 with potential increases at the end of a successful probationary period.
