### AUDITOR I/II/III

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking self-directed, detail-orientated individuals for Utility Regulatory Auditor positions located in our Jefferson City and Kansas City offices.

The individual in this position will perform audits and examinations of investor owned utility companies operating within the State of Missouri. Work includes presenting oral and written testimony in formal rate cases before the Commission. Up to 30% travel may be required. Work experience in this position qualifies for CPA certification.

Starting salary will be commensurate with your education and experience. All qualified candidates must have a general understanding of accounting principles and audit standards. Good communication, interpersonal and written skills are required, along with working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access software applications.

Candidates qualifying as a **Utility Regulatory Auditor I** position must possess a four-year degree from an accredited college or university with specialization in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or closely related area and must also have a minimum of twenty-four semester hours of accounting coursework. The starting annual salary for a Utility Regulator Auditor I is \$36,672 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period. May graduates are welcome to apply.

Candidates qualifying as a **Utility Regulatory Auditor II** must meet the minimum educational requirements of the Auditor I in addition to the requirements of one or more years of experience as a Utility Regulatory Auditor I with the Missouri Public Service Commission **or** two or more years of professional auditing experience, including one or more years in a regulatory environment that provides a broad view of regulation, utility operations, cost evaluation, and management analysis. The starting annual salary for a Utility Regulator Auditor II is \$38,724 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period.

Candidates qualifying as a **Utility Regulatory Auditor III** must meet the minimum educational requirements of the Auditor I in addition to the requirements of One or more years of experience as a Utility Regulatory Auditor II with the Missouri Public Service Commission **or** three or more years of professional auditing experience, including two or more years in a regulatory environment that provides a broad view of regulation, utility operations, cost evaluation, and management analysis. The starting annual salary for a Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$45,960 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period.
