The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a senior level attorney for its Office of Staff Counsel located in Jefferson City.

Duties include: Ability to manage complex cases involving state and federal regulatory matters; ability to work effectively as part of a team of attorneys and subject-matter experts; ability to write and speak persuasively; and the ability to mentor less-experienced attorneys in the practice of utility-regulatory law. The position serves as Deputy Counsel for utilities at the Public Service Commission. Moderate amount of travel in-state is required.

Qualifications: Must be member of the Missouri Bar or eligible through reciprocity. Ability to use computer word processing and other job-specific software required. The successful candidate will have experience demonstrating readiness to assume first chair responsibilities in administrative litigation and will demonstrate willingness to put in the time necessary to develop a thorough grasp of issues relating to the regulation of utilities. Prior experience in utility regulatory matters is useful but not required.
