The candidate selected for this position will manage all stages of complex case litigation and trial practice before all levels of courts and federal agencies. The successful applicant will have detailed knowledge of the Missouri rules of evidence, civil procedure, and trial practice. Experience in public utility regulation is preferred, but not required. The candidate must be admitted to practice law in Missouri and be a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar.
