## **UTILITY ENGINEERING SPECIALIST I/II**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a self-directed, detail-oriented individual for the position of Utility Engineering Specialist I/II in the Engineering and Management Services Unit of our Jefferson City office.

This is a highly responsible and professional position. The successful candidate will conduct depreciation studies of Missouri investor-owned utility plants and provide written and oral testimony of study findings. Position requires the ability to analyze, investigate, and perform technical engineering work related to utilities as well as the ability to advise and assist the Commission in discharging its statutory responsibilities. This position requires expertise in the area of depreciation analysis and utility regulation. Travel up to approximately 25% is required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an ABET accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in engineering (Engineering Specialist I) and two years of responsible utility related experience or training (Engineering Specialist II). EIT preferred. Personal computer experience required, Microsoft Office experience preferred. Must have strong inter-personal skills, be able to work within established time constraints as well as in a diverse group of professional staff. Ability to work within a team setting or independently is required. Must have initiative and strong work ethic.

The starting annual salary for the Utility Engineering Specialist I is \$47,892 and the Utility Engineering Specialist II is \$51,096 with a potential increase at the end of a satisfactory probationary period for each position.
