## UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR IV

The Missouri Public Service Commission is accepting applications for a Utility Regulatory Auditor IV position in its Water & Sewer Department. This is a highly responsible professional position requiring a high degree of technical and substantive knowledge in utility regulation, accounting and regulatory auditing.

This position assists in the coordination of policy decisions; assists legal staff with the preparation of briefs and cross-examination of witnesses; conducts research and analysis; plans, develops, and implements difficult and complex assignments and special projects; reviews reports, papers, and other records prepared by personnel; analyzes inquiries or proposals; conducts on-site utility audits, interviews workers, and examines records; supervises the preparation of data requests; confers with company officials to discuss financial problems and regulatory matters; reviews and evaluates prudency of utility applications; reviews utility budgetary controls; and analyzes financial information.

Qualified candidates must have a minimum of four years of professional auditing experience, of which three years must have been in a regulatory environment that provides a broad view of regulation, including such things as utility operations, cost evaluation or management analysis and a bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or a closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of accounting or finance coursework. Applicants must possess good communication and interpersonal skills. Personal computer experience required, with working knowledge of Microsoft Office preferred. Minimal travel required.

The salary range for this position is \$52,092 - \$56,520.
