### Missouri

### Public Service Commission

A substantial portion of the work of the Missouri Public Service Commission during the 1969-1970 fiscal year was devoted to rate increase cases.

Requests by public utilities for increases constituted the majority of the rate cases. The number of these proceedings before the Commission during the year totaled 34, a 36 per cent increase over the 25 cases before the Commission in the previous fiscal year.

Prior to 1968, in a typical year three or four rate cases were filed with the Commission.

A major factor in this abrupt rise in rate requests is inflation, which has raised the costs of labor, materials, capital and fuel.

The effects of inflation are made greater by the rising demand for the services provided by utilities. In order to keep pace with demand, many utilities have had to undertake expansion at a time when costs are high. Because utilities are charged with the responsibility of providing service to all, they cannot wait for a more favorable economic period to undertake expansion.

In deciding these rate cases, the Commission established rates that are reasonable for consumers and sufficient to maintain the soundness of the utilities.

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The rates set by the Commission in most cases were lower than those requested by the companies.

In nine of the 15 cases decided by June 30, 1970, the rates proposed by the company were subsequently reduced by the Commission. No increase was permitted in two cases, and the amount applied for was granted in four cases.

After the close of the fiscal year, 13 cases were completed. In 10 of those, the Commission prescribed amounts lower than requested and in three cases approved the rates submitted by the companies.

Among the other types of rate cases considered by the Commission were those for dump trucks, motor freight carriers and railroad freight and passenger operations.

These increases, except for the rates determined for dump trucks, corresponded to levels approved by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

The dump truck increase, which was 3 per cent for clay transportation and 6 per cent for other bulk commodities, was the first for the carriers since the Commission first prescribed rates for them in 1958.

In the Appendix of this report are listed the cases of all types considered by the Commission during the fiscal year.

The number of rate cases is expected to be about the same in the 1970-1971 fiscal year. Since the end of the period covered by this report, 16 new rate requests have been submitted to the Commission.

A change in this trend is not expected until the pressures exerted by inflation and demand relax.

The investment in plant by the companies serving Missouri has more than doubled in the last decade, but expenses have exceeded the growth in investment.

While plant investment has grown an average of 16.1 per cent annually and gross revenues have risen 16.6 per cent per year, expenses have increased at an annual rate of 17.4 per cent.

The interest rate that companies must pay for debt financing has risen from about 5 per cent at the beginning of the 1960s to 9 per cent.

The Commission must set rates at a level that will allow the companies to earn sufficient revenues to attract investment capital.

If rates are too low, this capability as well as the capability to meet present and future demands for service would be adversely affected. In order to maintain this balance between the consumer and the utility, the Commission continually checks the companies under its jurisdiction to determine whether their earnings are within the limits set by the Commission.

The Commission is required by law to give priority to rate cases, but simultaneously must dispose of a great number of other orders, investigations, hearings and appeals that comprise the balance of its workload.

In the course of the fiscal year, 1,500 cases were filed with the Commission. Hearings were conducted in 580 cases, and 5,480 orders were issued.

Seven cases were appealed; three to the Circuit Court and four from the Circuit Court to the Kansas City Court of Appeals. Two statutory penalty actions and one injunction action were filed. Nine opinions, which are rendered for the public, the Commission and the staff, were issued during the year.

More than 9,000 railroad, bus and truck tariffs were processed during the year. The operating rights of 572 motor carriers were revoked for failure to comply with Commission requirements.

The Commission suspended 1,291 carriers following cancelation of their insurance coverage. Of these, 769 later were reinstated upon filing proof of proper insurance.

Contacts were made with 2,995 motor carriers and 1,846 vehicles were inspected for compliance with safety regulations. Investigations were made of 34 accidents and 446 unlawful operations.

Tariffs filed by utility companies in the fiscal year totaled more than 2,800.

The staff conducted 525 field inspections concerning railroad safety, 128 field investigations of complaints, 55 gas safety inspections and nine explosion investigations. There were five incidents at utilities in which a fatality, an injury or property damage of at least \$1,000 occurred. Investigation showed that in two, the utility was at fault, while the remainder were beyond the company's control.

In excess of 4,700 letters were written in regard to utility complaints, tariffs and information requests. Telephone calls, conferences and other contacts numbered approximately 4,500.

A total of 31 utility company audits were in progress during the fiscal year, compared to 25 during the previous fiscal period.

Some of the companies under Commission jurisdiction that were faced with rising expenses and declining revenues asked for permission to discontinue service rather than a rate increase. In 1968 the Commission had denied the request of the Missouri Pacific Railroad to discontinue passenger service between St. Louis and Kansas City, but this decision was overruled in 1969 by the Interstate Commerce Commission.

In December, 1969, the Commission filed suit in U. S. District Court, joined by the City of Jefferson City and the United Transportation Union, and was granted an injunction preventing the discontinuance of service.

The Commission now is striving to have the route included in the National Rail Passenger Plan (Railpax) because it believes the route is needed not only by the citizens of Misssouri but for a more effective coast-to-coast rail passenger link.

The Commission also went to court to obtain an injunction against a bus line that attempted to cease operations without giving sufficient notice. Following investigation and hearings before the Commission, the line's request to abandon service was refused.

That company, and another company the Commission believed had contributed to the deterioration in service, were then made subjects of penalty suits in Circuit Court.

The economic situation faced by some companies is indicated in the case of an applicant who wished to initiate bus service where none existed. Upon finding that insurance costs would exceed anticipated revenues, the applicant withdrew the request for authority.

In the exercise of its duties, the Commission often must work outside of the state to represent the people of Missouri.

The Commission and staff members went to Washington, D. C., several times during the fiscal year, and also attended a number of conferences and seminars on regulation in other cities.

In Washington, the Commission participated in 13 cases before federal regulatory agencies, gave testimony on three occasions before Congressional committees and assisted the Interstate Commerce Commission in two rail freight rate cases.

Chairman William R. Clark, who for some time had advocated a change in the allocation of telephone costs between interstate and intrastate operations, was appointed in June, 1970, to a federal-state joint board formed to study the matter.

In the past, insufficient weight had been given to the equipment used most often for local calls but indispensable for long distance calling. As a result, local rates were disproportionately high in relation to long distance rates. This was evidenced by the lowering of long distance rates by the Federal Communications Commission at the same time intrastate rates were rising.

The joint board was established by the FCC at the urging of Chairman Clark and other state regulators who believed the states should have a role in the cost allocation.

As a result of the board's work, a more equitable distribution of the costs was approved by the FCC.

Chairman Clark also was appointed during the year to the Nuclear Power Policy Task Force of the Southern Governors' Conference, which assists the states in preparing for the expected growth in the use of nuclear generating plants.

Vice-Chairman Marvin E. Jones in June, 1970, was elected president of the Midwest Association of Railroad and Utilities Commissioners. Judge Jones previously was Second Vice-President of the organization, which provides a forum for the exchange of ideas and information on regulation.

Commissioner Howard Elliott, Jr., resigned from the PSC in December, 1970, to accept appointment to the newly-created U.S. Postal Rate Commission. Commissioner Elliott had served as a member of the PSC since April, 1967.

Other work performed by the Commission during the year concerned the promulgation of new rules and regulations and the improvement of existing ones.

An investigation was begun in March, 1970, to determine the value of a statewide code governing the underground placement of electric lines.

A number of municipalities have adopted ordinances requiring burial of lines, but are holding them in abeyance pending the completion of the Commission's work.

The adoption of a statewide code of this type would enable companies serving a number of areas to employ a uniform approach, rather than having to deal with a variety of local ordinances.

The code as proposed would set criteria for the installation of underground lines, including the areas in which undergrounding would be required, and also would set guidelines for the allocation of installation costs.

It would apply both to investor-owned electric utilities and to rural electric cooperatives.

The first phase of the Commission investigation covers lines in new residential subdivisions. Following completion of this work, the investigation would be directed to the study of undergrounding in high-density commercial areas.

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Hearings on the first phase are scheduled early in 1971.

Although the Missouri Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Code is equal to and in some areas more stringent than federal requirements, the U.S. Department of Transportation has not yet given the Commission final certification as the authority over pipeline safety in Missouri.

The DOT would prefer that the commissions it certifies have authority to assess penalties directly. The PSC, if it finds that penalties are in order, would file suit against the company in Circuit Court to obtain them, as required by Missouri law.

Two natural gas safety violation cases are now pending before the Commission. If the DOT approves of the Commission's actions in the case, the PSC may be granted DOT certification.

The Commission also is working toward promulgation of a uniform safety code for electric and telephone companies in Missouri.

These rules would pertain to the construction, operation and maintenance of electric and communications lines.

In the past, the Commission has set such regulations on a case-by-case basis. Additionally, some companies follow the National Electrical Safety Code of the National Bureau of Standards, portions of which may be included in the Commission's uniform code.

The Commission plans to conduct hearings on the proposed code early in 1971.

Another proposed rule change under consideration would expedite the investigation of railroad accidents.

At present, railroads are required to notify the Commission immediately when rail accidents result in loss of life to passengers or employes or when grade crossing accidents cause death or serious injury to any person.

The proposed change would require such notification for grade crossing accidents or derailments involving damage in the amount of \$10,000 or more to equipment and track.

The Commission has responded to the increasing complexity and magnitude of regulation by initiating the use of computers in the preparation of rate cases and the surveillance of regulated firms.

The first step was the compilation of a data base for utilities throughout the United States. This information is useful in determining the cost of equity capital for utilities in Missouri.

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In the future, the Commission plans to use the computers in making monthly cost analyses that will provide information concerning basic costs, permitting rapid determination of whether the companies are staying within the guidelines set by the Commission.

The computer work is performed on equipment in the offices of the Division of Mental Health and the State Highway Department.

In connection with its adoption of computer technology, the Commission is planning a conference on regulatory information systems.

The purpose of the conference, which is tentatively scheduled to be held in St. Louis in April, 1971, is to give all regulatory commissions, both state and federal, an opportunity to learn the techniques involved in applying electronic data processing to the several responsibilities of regulation.

It is expected that the conference will encourage a continuing exchange of information among agencies, thus lessening the cost involved in establishing and maintaining electronic data processing as a regulatory tool.

In order to improve the accuracy of reports filed by bus and truck companies, the Commission has increased its contact with carriers to assist them in preparation of the reports.

These efforts are expected to result in substantial savings of man hours in the long run. In the past, as much as 75 per cent of the reports submitted had to be returned to the carriers due to incompleteness or errors.

The budget of the Public Service Commission is appropriated from money contributed by the Commission to the Public Service Commission Fund and the State Highway Department Fund.

Revenue placed in the PSC Fund is obtained by assessments from utilities under Commission jurisdiction. The money deposited in the Highway Fund is collected from the sale of license stickers to carriers holding PSC authority.

The utility assessments, which are subject to Commission approval, are allocated on a base of the companies' gross revenues during the prior year.
