The Missouri Public Service Commission, the state agency responsible for the regulation of public utilities and telecommunications providers, is seeking a highly responsible attorney for the position of Assistant General Counsel, with an emphasis on employment law and general litigation. This position will report directly to the General Counsel and also provide advice on issues involving general personnel policy, contracts, business processes, and other responsibilities as assigned.

This candidate must have a combined 5 years of litigation experience in either the civil, administrative or employment law areas. The candidate selected for this position must demonstrate an ability to manage or coordinate all stages of complex case litigation and trial practice before all levels of the courts as well as state or federal agencies. The successful applicant will have the ability to effectively communicate with all levels of the organization and external contacts; strong oral and written communication skills; and proven ability to effectively develop trust, respect and cooperation across all areas of an organization and staff levels. Experience in government regulation and personnel law is preferred, but not required. The candidate must be admitted to practice law in Missouri and be a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar. This position is located in Jefferson City, Missouri.
