UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR I-II-III

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a detail oriented, self-motivated, professional individual to fill an Auditor I/II/III position in our Financial Analysis Unit, Jefferson City office.

Individuals in the Financial Analysis Unit are responsible for analyzing and interpreting capital markets, with specific emphasis on estimating the cost of capital for utility companies. This requires the ability to apply, understand, and interpret cost of capital theories and applications such as the discounted cash flow/dividend discount methods, the Capital Asset Pricing Model, risk premium methodologies, etc. An individual in this position must be able to understand and interpret quarterly and annual financial statements as well as apply and interpret various credit ratios, profitability ratios and valuation ratios.

The position requires the ability to accurately prepare and present financial recommendations/testimony, in both oral and written form in quasi-judicial proceedings before the Commission. The employee in this position must be able to communicate financial/capital market analysis in an effective manner with little supervision and a degree of independent judgment. The employee will be expected to independently research academic studies and investment reports as they relate to cost of capital and valuation principles. Auditors must possess a high level of competence, responsibility, professionalism, initiative and integrity. This position has qualified for years of experience needed to attain the Chartered Financial Analyst ("CFA") designation. Some travel required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in finance, economics, accounting, business or public administration or closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of finance or accounting coursework required. **May graduates are welcome to apply.** Good communication, interpersonal skills, and writing skills are essential. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint, with special emphasis on spreadsheet/Excel knowledge and skills.

The annual salary for Utility Regulatory Auditor I is \$38,304; Utility Regulatory Auditor II is \$40,416; and Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$47,868 with potential increases at the end of a successful probationary period.
