## **DEPUTY COUNSEL**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a senior level attorney for its Staff Counsel Department located in Jefferson City.

Duties include: Ability to manage complex cases involving state and federal regulatory matters. The position serves as Deputy Counsel for water and sewer issues at the Public Service Commission. Moderate amount of travel in-state is required.

Qualifications: Three (3) years of responsible relevant legal experience in one or more fields of law directly related to the field of public utility regulation or in the field of administrative law; or five (5) years of general litigation experience required. Must be a member of the Missouri Bar or eligible through reciprocity. The successful candidate will have experience demonstrating readiness to assume first chair responsibilities in administrative litigation and will demonstrate willingness to put in the time necessary to develop a thorough grasp of issues relating to the regulation of the water and sewer industry. Ability to use computer word processing and other job-specific software required.
