The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking an Information Technology Specialist I to join our Information Services team in the Jefferson City office.

Responsibilities include: application development using C# in a .NET framework environment, systems analysis, database design and administration, maintenance of legacy applications and existing database management systems.

QUALIFICATIONS: One or more years of experience as an Information Technologist IV with the Missouri Uniform Classification and Pay System; or a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a minimum of 15 earned credit hours in computer science/computer information technology; and, five or more years of experience in application development, 2 of which must be using C# in a .NET environment.

Preference given to candidates with:

- Experience as a systems analyst including analyzing, designing and implementing information systems;
- Experience with SQL Server (database design, T-SQL queries, stored procedures, triggers, etc.);
- Experience with JavaScript and various frameworks, specifically jQuery;
- Experience in design and layout using HTML and CSS;
- Exposure to Microsoft .NET framework version 4 and Visual Studio 2013;
- Knowledge of source control fundamentals (exposure to Kiln/Mercurial a plus).
