The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a Legal Counsel for its Staff Counsel Department in Jefferson City. This is an entry-level position.

Duties include: litigation of public utility cases (telecommunications, electric, natural gas, water and sewer) before the PSC on behalf of Commission Staff. Cases involve matters such as utility rates, utility operation financing, mergers and regulatory law enforcement of Commission rules and laws.

QUALIFICATIONS: A juris doctorate degree and admission to practice law in Missouri or admission elsewhere and eligibility for admission to practice law in Missouri is required. Experience in general litigation, administrative law, and/or government regulation of private enterprise is desirable but not required.
