MANUFACTURED HOUSING INSPECTOR I-II

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a detail-oriented individual to complete inspections and enforce manufactured home and modular unit construction codes and standards in northwest Missouri.

This position works from a home office and is responsible for the inspection of manufactured homes, modular units, and dealer premises for compliance with state and federal regulations governing the manufactured home and modular unit industries. Work involves conducting inspections of manufactured housing units; investigating consumer complaints; verifying applications for certificates and state/federal seals; and ensuring compliance with the requirements for submission of registration and license fees.

QUALIFICATIONS: A high school diploma or a GED certificate, plus three years of experience in construction, building trades, fabricating, installing and/or servicing of manufactured housing or modular units, or related fields; or possession of an Associate degree, or 60 or more earned credit hours from an accredited college, university or trade school and one year of experience in construction, building trades, fabricating, installing, and/or servicing of manufactured housing or modular units or related fields. Applicable ICC certifications preferred. Extensive travel within assigned territory required.

Starting annual salary range is \$30,120 - \$38,544 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period.
