MANUFACTURED HOUSING PROGRAM MANAGER

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a manager to supervise the inspection and enforcement of construction and building code standards for manufactured housing and modular units in accordance with state and federal laws, rules, and regulations. Duties include fiscal, administrative and legislative responsibilities, as well as supervision of a technical and support staff. The manager coordinates the investigation of consumer complaints, files formal complaints against dealers and acts as liaison between the regulatory agency, the consumer and the industry. Position requires thorough knowledge of Department of Housing and Urban Development Code, Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards, Modular Unit Building Codes and local, state, and national building construction codes and regulations.

Successful applicant will demonstrate effective communication and presentation skills. Degree in engineering, business or public administration, or related field with four years of applicable professional or technical experience required. Relevant supervisory experience in the manufactured housing industry involving manufacturing, servicing, inspecting or retail sales may be substituted for required education. Applicable ICC certifications preferred. Periodic travel required.

Annual salary range is \$45,108 - \$54,360; salary commensurate with experience.
