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### **UTILITY POLICY ANALYST II**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a Utility Policy Analyst II. This position will primarily be involved with reviewing, analyzing and writing recommendations and presenting testimony to the commission concerning electric utility resource planning, fuel adjustment clauses, demand-side management (DSM) programs, DSM programs' evaluation, measurement and verification, DSM market potential studies, and demand-side programs investment mechanisms.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** One year of experience as a Utility Policy Analyst I with the Missouri Public Service Commission or five years of professional experience in management analysis, fiscal or financial analysis, or operations analysis, of which three years must have been in a regulatory environment; and graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in engineering, finance, accounting, economics, business or public administration, or a closely related field. (Graduate work in the specified educational areas may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for up to two years of the required general experience.) Good communication skills a must.

Starting annual salary range is \$52,680 - \$54,864. Salary is commensurate with education and experience.
