#### **RATE AND TARIFF EXAMINER I/II**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is accepting applications for the position of Rate and Tariff Examiner I/II in the Rate & Tariff Department.

This position reviews tariff proposals from regulated energy companies in Missouri and prepares recommendations for the Commission. Other duties include advising and assisting utilities in preparation and filing tariffs and certificate applications, compiling statistical data, systematically keeping track of all pending filings under review, as well as preparing customer replies to complaints and inquiries relating to energy company tariffs, Commission rules, regulations and procedures. The position will also be expected to testify before the Commission and assist in special projects and energy cases.

Qualified candidates will possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in engineering, finance, accounting, economics, business or public administration or a related field. Technical experience in a utility or regulatory environment involving the determination of rates and tariffs or work specializing in statistical, technical, or procedural analysis or other related work may be substituted for deficiencies in the required education. Experience using word-processing, spreadsheet, database or other similar software required.

The starting annual salary range is \$33,420 to \$38,700 with a potential increase at the end of successful probationary period.
