REGULATORY ECONOMIST III

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking to fill a Regulatory Economist III position in our Jefferson City office. The employee in this position applies economic principles in the analysis of electric and natural gas utility issues and makes recommendations to the Commission, primarily as an expert witness in cases before the Commission.

Duties include analyzing consumer usage and demand, performing cost studies, designing retail rates, and evaluating market power and economic performance. Additional responsibilities include providing recommendations to the Commission on tariff filings and certificate applications.

QUALIFICATIONS: One year as Regulatory Economist II with the Missouri Public Service Commission; or four years of professional or technical experience performing economic analyses using statistical methods and techniques in a regulatory or utility environment and graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a minimum of 24 earned credit hours in one or a combination of the following: Economics, Engineering, Finance, Mathematics, or Statistics, including 3 earned credit hours in Econometrics, Microeconomic Theory, Regulatory Economics or a closely related field; or two years of professional applied research or teaching experience at the college level in the field of economics, and a Master's degree in economics; or one year of professional experience performing economic analyses in a regulatory or utility environment and successful completion of all coursework requirements for a Ph.D. in economics. Experience working with Excel formulas in spreadsheets and word processing is essential. Additional computer simulation and database experience is preferred. The ability to work well in a team environment is a must.

The annual salary range is \$54,276 to \$56,520 with a potential salary increase at the completion of a successful probationary period.
