RULES AND TARIFF ANALYST

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking to fill a Rules and Tariff Analyst position in our Tariff/Rate Design Department in the Jefferson City office. This position will perform analysis and provide recommendations related to energy issues that affect Missouri's investor owned utilities and their customers.

This position will be responsible for developing and conducting research studies and/or assessing the impact of proposed utility applications and tariff filings, and presenting findings to state agencies, senior policy makers, and other stakeholders. Work involves research, serve as technical consultants, review tariffs, and testify before the Missouri Public Service Commission. Employees in this position plan, develop, and present new ideas, concepts, and strategies related to systems and techniques. The position requires the ability to understand the interrelation of tariff mechanisms on Missouri ratepayers. The position also requires extremely detailed verification of analyses presented by regulated utilities, written, and oral testimony. This position will be responsible for developing written recommendations to present to the Commission and will be required to testify under cross-examination from other stakeholders.

Qualified candidates must have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and 2-4 years of relevant experience. Experience with spreadsheets and word processing is essential. The ability to work well independently and in a team environment is a must. Strong written and oral communication of technical subjects as well as the ability to comprehend and interpret technical writing are essential to this position.

Starting salary will be commensurate with education and experience. The annual salary range for a Research/Data Analyst is \$60,054 - \$66,053 plus benefits. Benefits include 13 paid holidays annually, 10 hours paid sick and vacation time each month, potential telecommuting options, flexible work schedules, physical fitness opportunities, and tuition reimbursement. The position also offers optional life, medical, dental and vision coverage, and the state employee pension plan.
