### SAFETY INSPECTOR

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a self-directed, detail-oriented individual to complete inspections and enforce manufactured home and modular unit construction codes and standards in northeastern Missouri.

**Salary:** Starting salary will be commensurate with education and experience. Annual salary range: \$46,779 - \$53,776 plus benefits. *(The salary listed reflects the base pay rate. Verified prior state service, subject to applicable eligibility requirements, may increase total compensation.)*

**Job Location:** This position's territory will be northeastern Missouri including St. Louis

#### Why you'll love this position:

The Missouri Public Service Commission regulates investor-owned electric, natural gas, steam, water and sewer utilities in Missouri. We ensure that Missourians receive safe and reliable utility services at just, reasonable and affordable rates. The Manufactured Housing Department is responsible by statute, Chapter 700, for the annual registrations of manufacturers, dealers, and installers of manufactured homes and modular units sold within the State. Manufactured Housing is the State Administrative Agency (SAA) for the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) and is responsible for prescribing and enforcing uniform construction standards; the installation of manufactured homes and modular units including classrooms; approving plans for modular units; and enforcing tie-down anchoring requirements.

#### What you'll do:

- Responsible for the inspection of manufactured homes, modular units, and dealer premises for compliance with state and federal regulations governing the manufactured home and modular unit industries.
- Conduct inspections of manufactured housing units.
- Investigate consumer complaints.
- Verify applications for certificates and state/federal seals.
- Ensure compliance with the requirements for submission of registration and license fee.
- Position will require occasional in and out of state travel.
- Extensive travel within assigned territory required. Occasional overnight travel may be required.

#### All you need for success:

##### Minimum Qualifications

- Two or more years of relevant experience (i.e. construction, building trades, fabricating, installing and/or servicing of manufactured housing or modular units) and/or appropriate certification.
- Applicable ICC certifications preferred.
- Must have initiative and strong work ethic.
