TECHNICAL ADVISOR TO THE COMMISSION

The Public Service Commission is seeking a Technical Advisor to serve as an independent technical and policy advisor to the Commission. This position requires advising and assisting the Commissioners and the Commission's regulatory law judges in various areas of utility regulation, including traditional rate of return issues, legislative and consumer-related issues, and federally mandated changes to the energy, electric, natural gas, water, sewer, and telecommunications industries. Position is located in Jefferson City, with moderate travel involved.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with a specialization in one or more of the following disciplines: accounting, economics, finance, engineering/utility operations, law, or public policy. Three years of professional experience in the energy sector, a utility, or regulatory environment required, five years experience preferred. Advanced degree in the specified educational areas may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for up to three years of professional experience. Must be a self-starter, capable of conducting independent research in a timely manner, and anticipating the needs of the Commission.

The annual salary range for this position is \$55,000 to \$70,000.
