### **ENGINEER**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking an individual with a technical engineering background to work as a Utility Engineering Specialist III/Utility Regulatory Engineer I in the Water & Sewer Department of our Jefferson City office.

The person in this position will perform system inspections and special investigations related to the various regulatory requirements that affect Missouri's investor-owned water and sewer utilities and their customers. This position requires a good understanding of the principles and practices of engineering as applied to the water and sewer utility industries in the areas of system design, construction, operation, and maintenance. The position also requires a good understanding of the federal, state, and local regulations related to the water and sewer industries, and a basic understanding of the engineering and accounting factors relative to the development of water and sewer utility rate structures.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Three years of engineering experience, of which one year must have been in a regulatory, compliance or utility environment; and graduation from a college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering or equivalent from an ABET accredited college or university. Graduate work in the specified educational areas may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the required general experience. PE eligibility in Missouri required. Missouri PE required for Utility Regulatory Engineer I. The applicant must also possess a high level of both verbal and written communication skills and the ability to explain technical information to both technical and non-technical audiences required. Computer literacy and the ability to work well in a team environment is a must. Some travel is required.

The annual salary range is \$57,220 - \$62,020.
