UTILITY MANAGEMENT ANALYST I/II

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a self-directed, detail-oriented individual for the position of Utility Management Analyst in our Customer Experience Department in the Jefferson City office.

This position performs operational, service quality and management analyses of Missouri regulated utilities, reports on the effectiveness and efficiency of Missouri regulated electric, gas, telephone, water and sewer utilities and examines utility proposals related to customer experiences and expectations. Conducts special studies and investigations, prepares recommendations, and provides written and oral testimony to the Commission. Provides analytical support to senior staff members within the Department. Some travel required.

QUALIFICATIONS – Minimum qualifications are graduation from an accredited fouryear college or university with specialization in operations research, industrial engineering, finance, accounting, economics, business or public administration, or a closely related field. Personal computer experience required, Microsoft Office experience preferred. Must have strong inter-personal, communication, and writing skills. Ability to work within a team setting or independently is required. Must have initiative and strong work ethic.

The starting annual salary range for a Utility Management Analyst I is \$31,608 - \$36,276 and the starting salary range for the Utility Management Analyst II is \$36,924 - \$42,000.
