The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking an individual with strong analytical skills and a technical background to work as a Utility Operations Technical Specialist in our Water and Sewer Department.

Duties include performing on-site evaluations and reviewing records related to the operation of Commission regulated water and sewer utilities in Missouri, and preparing written reports and recommendations regarding such activities. Position will also investigate and resolve operations-related complaints and prepare written testimony and exhibits for hearings before the Commission in docketed cases. Approximately 30% travel.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with specialization in engineering or related technical field or four years of technical experience in a related field required. Good verbal and written communication skills and computer literacy required. Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and Access preferred. Working knowledge of the principles and practices applied in conducting on-site evaluations of utility facilities and systems operations, investigating customer complaints and in the construction and operation of utilities preferred.

Salary range for the Specialist I: \$38,304 - \$41,184; salary range for the Specialist II: \$42,780 - \$44,352.
