Critical Infrastructure Security Engineer

State agency seeks to fill a Critical Infrastructure Engineer position to serve as liaison between the agency, utilities, and the Missouri Information Analysis Center. This position will review and analyze information received related to known and perceived cybersecurity and physical security threats to Missouri's critical utility infrastructure. This position will NOT investigate or provide recommendations on utility infrastructure or processes. The position may also require preparation and presentation of reports or recommendations in proceedings before the Public Service Commission.

A high level of verbal and written communication skills are required. The ability to explain and interpret the results of complex technical information to technical and non-technical audiences is strongly desired.

QUALIFICATIONS: Four years of engineering experience or experience in information security, cybersecurity or infrastructure security, two of which must have been in a regulatory environment; and graduation from a college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering with additional education or experience in Information Security, Cybersecurity or Information Assurance a plus. Experience with utilities, critical infrastructure or cybersecurity preferred, but not required. Graduate work in the specified educational areas may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the required general experience. Missouri PE required. The applicant must also possess strong analytical, writing, verbal and interpersonal skills. The position requires personal computer experience, including developing and analyzing data in electronic spreadsheets.

The starting annual salary range is \$58,896 to \$66,672 with a potential increase at the end of a satisfactory probationary period.
