UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR

The Auditing Department of the Financial and Business Analysis Division of the Missouri Public Service Commission seeks to fill a Utility Regulatory Auditor position in their Jefferson City Unit to perform analysis related to issues that affect Missouri's investorowned utilities and their customers.

The individual in this position will perform audits and examinations of investor-owned utility companies operating within the State of Missouri. Work includes presenting oral and written testimony in formal rate cases before the Commission. Up to 30% travel may be required. Work experience in this position qualifies for CPA certification.

Qualified candidates must have a Bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or a closely related field, and twenty-four or more credit hours of accounting or finance coursework and 0-2 years of professional auditing experience. Must be familiar with generally accepted accounting principles and audit standards. Good communication, interpersonal skills, and writing skills are essential. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access software applications preferred.

Starting salary will be commensurate with education and experience. Annual salary range: \$41,620 - \$46,171.
