UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR I/II/III

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking a self-directed, detail-oriented individual for a Utility Regulatory Auditor I/II/III position in our Procurement Analysis Unit, Jefferson City office.

The individual in this position will perform audits and examinations of investor owned utility companies operating within the State of Missouri. Work includes presenting oral and written testimony in formal rate cases before the Commission. Occasional travel may be required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of accounting and finance coursework required. **May graduates are welcome to apply.** Must be familiar with generally accepted accounting principles and audit standards. Good communication, interpersonal skills, and writing skills are essential. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access software applications preferred.

The annual starting salary for a Utility Regulatory Auditor I is \$38,304; Utility Regulatory Auditor II is \$40,416; and Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$47,868 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period.
