UTILITY REGULATORY AUDITOR I/II/III

The Missouri Public Service Commission Tariff/Rate Design Department is seeking an Auditor in our Jefferson City office. Duties include performing audits and examinations related to tariff issues that affect Missouri's investor owned electric, steam, and natural gas utilities and their customers.

This is a responsible, professional position that will review requests that will have impacts in utility ratemaking. The position also requires extremely detailed verification of analyses presented by regulated utilities, consultants, and other interested parties. The auditor in this position will develop and make recommendations, including written and oral testimony, to the Commission based on the results of his/her analysis of the issues.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with specialization in accounting, finance, economics, business or public administration or closely related area, including or supplemented by twenty-four semester hours of accounting or finance coursework required. **December graduates are welcome to apply.** Starting salary will be commensurate with education and experience. Must be familiar with generally accepted accounting principles and audit standards. Good communication, interpersonal skills, and writing skills are essential. Computer experience required with a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access software applications preferred. The ability to work well in a team environment is a must.

Annual salary for Utility Regulatory Auditor I is \$39,708; Utility Regulatory Auditor II is \$42,000; and Utility Regulatory Auditor III is \$48,852.
