UTILITY ENGINEERING SPECIALIST III/UTILITY REGULATORY ENGINEER I

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking two (2) self-directed, detail-oriented individuals for positions of Utility Engineering Specialist III/Utility Regulatory Engineer I in the Utility Services Department of our Jefferson City office. These are highly responsible and professional positions.

One opening is for a position that reviews and conducts depreciation studies of Missouri investor-owned utilities. This position requires expertise in the area of depreciation analysis and utility regulation. Travel up to approximately 25% is required. Knowledge of depreciation software is preferred.

One opening is for a position that investigates, reviews, and analyzes plans and activities, including costs, of natural gas distribution companies operating in the State of Missouri. This position requires experience in developing and analyzing data in electronic spreadsheets, and diligence in seeking out information. Some travel is required.

Both positions require written reports and/or testimony of study findings. The positions also require the ability to analyze, investigate, and perform technical engineering work related to utilities as well as the ability to advise and assist the Commission in discharging its statutory responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS: Three years of engineering experience, of which one year is preferred in a regulatory, compliance or utility environment; and graduation from a college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, with the curriculum approved by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology, Inc. Engineer in Training (E.I.T.) Certification from the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) is preferred. Missouri Professional Engineer (P.E.) license required for Utility Regulatory Engineer I. The applicant must also possess strong analytical, writing and interpersonal skills with the demonstrated ability to work well with a diverse group of professionals. Personal computer experience is required.

Starting annual salary for these positions is \$52,176 - \$59,016 with a potential increase at the end of a satisfactory probationary period.
