UTILITY POLICY ANALYST I

The Missouri Public Service Commission is seeking an individual with strong analytical skills and a technical background to work as a Utility Policy Analyst I in our Water and Sewer Unit.

Duties include performing on-site inspections, occasionally assisting with day-to-day operations and reviewing records related to the operation of Commission regulated water and sewer utilities in Missouri, and preparing written reports and recommendations regarding such activities. Position will also prepare written recommendations and testimony for Commission consideration. Approximately 15% travel.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with specialization in engineering, economics, accounting, business or closely related field; and four years of relevant professional experience, of which two years must have been in a regulatory environment. Graduate work in the specified areas may be substituted for a portion of the required experience. Excellent verbal and written communication skills and computer proficiency also required. Also, must be willing to obtain appropriate water and wastewater certifications from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

Starting annual salary range is \$43,488 - \$45,156 with a potential increase at the end of a successful probationary period.
