## Submit Comments in Writing

**Comments should not include any personal or sensitive information that you do not wish to be made public.**

## Attend Public Hearings and Provide Testimony

The Commission holds public hearings to provide an opportunity for consumers to express their views, opinions and concerns about a case before the Commission. Your statement will be transcribed by a court reporter and will be part of the official case record.
