

MISSOURI ENERGY TASK FORCE RESOLUTION #2

WHEREAS, reliable and affordable energy is essential to the welfare of Missouri Citizens; and

WHEREAS, Governor Blunt has appointed the Missouri Energy Task Force to provide specific recommendations to lessen Missouri's dependence on fossil fuels; and

WHEREAS, Governor Blunt believes the state should lead by example; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Administration has already implemented energy conservation and cost savings plans for their facilities; and

WHEREAS, such energy conservation and cost savings plans should be adopted by all state agencies.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Missouri Energy Task Force recommends that the Members of the Missouri House of Representatives and the Missouri Senate pass legislation to require all state agencies to implement energy conservation and cost savings plans.

THEREFORE, be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to all members of the Missouri General Assembly.
