NOTICE REGARDING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE AND PARTICIPATION IN THE SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

Issue Date: July 26, 2016

On July 1, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff designed to increase its revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established July 25 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene. A scheduling conference will be held on July 28.

The Commission has granted intervention requests by the Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy. Brightergy, LLC; Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri; United for Missouri, Inc.; the Natural Resources Defense Council; Sierra Club; and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group have also filed timely applications to intervene, and IBEW Local 1439 filed an application to intervene a day late. The Commission has not yet taken up those applications to intervene because the requisite time to respond has not yet passed.

All prospective intervening parties are invited to attend the July 28 scheduling conference and the Commission will take up their applications to intervene while on the record at the conference.
