NOTICE THAT TARIFF WILL BE ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT

On February 14, 2017, the Commission's Staff filed a motion to suspend or reject a tariff filed by Missouri Gas Energy, an operating unit of Laclede Gas Company (MGE). The challenged tariff bears an effective date of February 22, 2017, and would establish certain promotional practices, including product rebates. Staff's motion contends that one such rebate has not been shown to be cost-effective and is thus improper. The Commission did not immediately take any action regarding MGE's tariff, but instead directed that any party wishing to respond to Staff's motion do so no later than February 16.

MGE responded to Staff's motion on February 16, explaining that it has filed a substitute tariff sheet that eliminates the challenged rebate. Staff replied later on February 16, confirming that the filing of the substitute tariff sheet eliminating the challenged rebate satisfies Staff's objection to the tariff. Staff now recommends that MGE's tariff be allowed to go into effect on its proposed effective date.

In effect, Staff has withdrawn its motion to suspend or reject MGE's tariff.

Therefore, the Commission will take no action regarding that tariff and it will be allowed to go into effect on its effective date.
