
On August 3, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) against Daybreak Ranches, Inc. and Overlook Property Owner’s Association. On May 12, 2017, Staff filed a pleading voluntarily dismissing its formal complaint.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complainant may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or

oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of Staff's dismissal. This case shall be closed.
