**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING FILE**

Issue Date: June 13, 2017

On January 20, 2017, the Commission's Staff filed a complaint against the Respondents alleging that they have failed to provide safe and adequate water service to their customers. On June 5, Staff filed a motion seeking leave to dismiss its complaint, indicating its concerns about the operation have been resolved by the appointment of an interim receiver to operate Ridge Creek Water Company and Ridge Creek Development Company.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides that a complainant may dismiss its complaint at any time before prepared testimony has been filed without an order from

the Commission. No prepared testimony has been filed in this case, so Staff does not need leave to dismiss its complaint; the Commission will simply acknowledge its dismissal. This file may now be closed.
