## NOTICE CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND NOTICE OF COMMUNICATION

The prehearing conference scheduled for 2:00 p.m., September 5, 2017, is canceled. Unfortunately, due to a miscommunication between the Regulatory Law Judge and Ms. Jill Covington Beatty, Ms. Covington Beatty appeared in-person for the prehearing conference at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's offices.

The Regulatory Law Judge spoke with Ms. Covington Beatty about the fact that several messages were left on the available telephone numbers Ms. Covington Beatty gave, but the Regulatory Law Judge had been unable to contact her to inform her that the conference could not be scheduled for 10:00 a.m., but had been set for 2:00 p.m. Ms. Covington Beatty was unable to stay in Jefferson City until 2:00 p.m. and requested that this matter be brought closer to her home in Caruthersville, Missouri. The Regulatory Law Judge indicated that a hearing would be set in Caruthersville if a

suitable location could be found. If a location cannot be set in Caruthersville it will be set in a nearby town with suitable accommodations for the hearing.

In discussions about when to have the hearing, Ms. Covington Beatty indicated that she would be available on September 26<sup>th</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup> for a hearing. The Regulatory Law Judge told Ms. Covington Beatty that she would attempt to schedule a hearing for one of those dates. The Regulatory Law Judge has also exchanged email with the attorneys for the other parties to this case with regard to scheduling conflicts. A separate order setting the time and place for the hearing will be issued.
