NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Issue Date: April 5, 2018

On March 13, 2018, Rosemary Prude filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On April 3, 2018, Ms. Prude filed a voluntary dismissal of her complaint. The dismissal notes that the parties have reached an agreement that resolves the dispute and the complaint is dismissed with prejudice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complainant may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of the dismissal. This case is now closed.
