NOTICE THAT APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE HAVE BEEN GRANTED

Issue Date: June 8, 2018

On May 21, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Schuyler and Adair Counties in Missouri. Ameren Missouri's application also seeks approval of a Renewable Energy Standard Cost Recovery Mechanism (RESRAM), and a waiver of certain Commission rules.

The Natural Resources Defense Council, The Missouri Department of Conservation, and Sierra Club filed timely applications to intervene. Those applications were taken up on the record at the procedural conference held on June 8. Each application to intervene was granted and the named entities are now parties to this case
