NOTICE THAT APPLICATION TO INTERVENE HAS BEEN GRANTED

Issue Date: June 14, 2018

The Commission opened this case on June 6, 2018, to adjust the electric rates of The Empire District Electric Company pursuant to Section 393.137 of Missouri’s statutes, passed as part of Senate Bill 564 during the second regular session of the 99th General Assembly. That statute gives the Commission one-time authority to order an adjustment to the electric rates of an electrical corporation in light of the recently enacted Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017.

The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy filed a timely application to intervene. That application was taken up on the record at the procedural conference held on June 14, and was granted. The Division of Energy is now a party to this case.
