On December 8, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Smithview H2O Company, John Kuhle, and Kuhle H2O Company regarding the filing of its annual report, payment of annual assessments, provision of safe and adequate services and provision of unauthorized services. On May 21, 2019, Staff filed a notice indicating it has voluntarily dismissed its complaint following the completion of the sale of Smithview H2O Company to Confluence Rivers Operating Company.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides that a complainant may voluntarily dismiss its complaint at any time before prepared testimony has been filed without an order from the Commission.
