On January 30, 2020, Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water), LLC d/b/a Liberty Utilities filed notice, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1), indicating its intent to file an application with the Commission for a certificate of convenience and necessity.
