ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE OF CONSUMERS COUNCIL OF MISSOURI, MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS, AND MISSOURI DIVISION OF ENERGY

On July 1, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff designed to increase its revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established July 25 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

On July 13, the Consumers Council of Missouri applied to intervene. Consumers Council is a nonprofit corporation dedicated to educating and empowering consumers and advocating for their interests.

On July 15, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene. MIEC is a nonprofit Missouri corporation and its members are large industrial customers of Ameren Missouri.

On July 15, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy applied to intervene. The Division of Energy is a state agency with statutory authority to plan for future energy needs and energy resource development.

More than ten days have passed since Consumers Council, MIEC, and Division of Energy applied to intervene and no party has objected to those applications.

The Commission finds that Consumers Council's, MIEC's and Division of Energy's interests in this case differ from those of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Consumers Council, MIEC, and Division of Energy to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of the Consumers Council of Missouri is granted.
2. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.
3. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy is granted.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
