**ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Commission established a procedural schedule in its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on June 24, 2016. On August 8, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri; the Commission’s Staff; the Office of the Public Counsel; Brightergy, LLC; the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy; and United for Missouri, Inc. (“Movants”) filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule. Movants have requested more time to file rebuttal testimony to facilitate settlement negotiations among the parties. No other party has objected to the motion by the response deadline set by the Commission. The Commission wishes to encourage the parties to negotiate a settlement of this matter, so it will grant Movants’ request to extend the deadline for filing rebuttal testimony to August 25, 2016.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri; the Commission’s Staff; the Office of the Public Counsel; Brightergy, LLC; the Missouri Department of Economic

Development – Division of Energy; and United for Missouri, Inc.’s *Joint Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* filed on August 8, 2016, is granted.

2. The deadline for the parties to file rebuttal testimony in this case is extended until no later than August 25, 2016.

3. All other provisions of the Commission’s *Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on June 24, 2016, shall remain unchanged.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
