ORDER REGARDING RESPONSES TO AMENDED COMPLAINT

Issue Date: August 15, 2016

Effective Date: August 15, 2016

The complainants filed the *Complaint*.¹ The Commission issued its orders governing responses² to the *Complaint*. Then the complainants filed the *Amended Complaint*³ setting forth fewer charges than the *Complaint*. The Commission’s regulations provide:

. . . Parties shall be allowed ten (10) days from the date of filing in which to respond to an amended pleading unless otherwise ordered by the commission. [⁴]

But responses under that regulation are due sooner, and need address fewer charges, than responses as currently ordered. Therefore, to avoid confusion as to the responses required, the Commission will order the following.

 - b. Address only the content of the *Amended Complaint*.
