**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF APPLICATION,
ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION FILING DATE**

On July 25, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) filed its *Notice of Start of Second MEEIA Prudence Audit*. Staff stated it started its second MEEIA prudence audit of the costs associated with Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri’s Demand Side Investment Mechanism (“DSIM”) for the period July 1, 2014, through December 31, 2105. Staff plans to file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis no later than December 22, 2016.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.093(10)(B) establishes a one hundred sixty day deadline of January 1, 2017, for parties to file a request for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will direct notice be provided of Staff’s audit and set a deadline for the filing of applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each party to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri’s most recent triennial Integrated Resource Plan case, File No. EO-2015-0084, and to the county commission of each county within Ameren Missouri’s service area.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the counties within Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's service area, and to the news media serving that service area.

3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than September 12, 2016.

4. This order shall become effective when issued.
