ORDER SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSE

On August 22, 2016, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) jointly filed a motion to modify the Commission approved stipulations and agreements in the above-captioned cases. KCP&L and GMO request that the Commission modify the previously approved stipulations so that these companies are no longer required to perform an analysis needed to produce a 2017 Interim Report and are not required to produce a 2017 Interim Report as previously ordered. The companies plead that the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), the Office of the Public Counsel, Southwest Power Pool, and Dogwood Energy, LLC, have each indicated that they do not object to the motion.

The Commission will set a time for responses to the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Responses to the Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion to Modify Stipulations shall be filed no later than September 2, 2016.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
