ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On July 22, 2016, Transource Missouri, LLC filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order declining jurisdiction, or, in the alternative, granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2000. The CCN would authorize Transource Missouri to own, operate, and maintain a 345 kilovolt (“kV”) Interconnection Switch Station in DeKalb County, Missouri that will connect the Osborn Wind Energy Center with Transource Missouri’s Sibley-Nebraska City 345 kV electric transmission line project. The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy filed an application to intervene on August 17. Osborn Wind Energy, LLC, applied to intervene on August 19. More than ten days have passed since the applications to intervene were filed and no response to either application has been filed.

The Commission finds that allowing the applicants to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy is granted.
2. The Application to Intervene of Osborn Wind Energy, LLC, is granted.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
