United for Missouri, Inc. (UFM) filed a *Request of United for Missouri to be Dismissed as a Party* on September 8, 2016. The motion asks the Commission to grant leave for David C. Linton to withdraw as counsel for UFM<sup>1</sup> and dismiss UFM as a party to this case. The Commission will grant the motion.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Request of United for Missouri to be Dismissed as a Party* is granted.
2. David C. Linton is granted leave to withdraw as counsel for United for Missouri, Inc.
3. United for Missouri, Inc. is dismissed.
4. The Commission's Data Center shall note the change of counsel in the Commission's records.
