ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On August 15, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed an application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve a tariff authorizing a pilot program to install and operate electric vehicle charging stations at locations within Ameren Missouri’s service area along the Interstate 70 corridor between St. Louis and Boonville, Missouri, and in Jefferson City, Missouri.

On August 15, 2016, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the application and setting a deadline of August 31, 2016 for persons requesting to intervene in this matter. The Midwest Energy Consumers Group; the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy; Natural Resources Defense Council; Brightergy, LLC; ChargePoint, Inc.; Sierra Club; Consumers Council of Missouri; and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers filed timely applications to intervene. No party has objected to the applications to intervene. The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by the Midwest Energy Consumers Group is granted.

2. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy is granted.

3. The application to intervene filed by the Natural Resources Defense Council is granted.

4. The application to intervene filed by Brightergy, LLC is granted.

5. The application to intervene filed by ChargePoint, Inc. is granted.

6. The application to intervene filed by Sierra Club is granted.

7. The application to intervene filed by Consumers Council of Missouri is granted.

8. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.

9. This order shall be effective when issued.
